JOB PURPOSE:

Education Officer – Numeracy to concentrate on Numeracy work with the aim of improving the numeracy level of students.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. To develop Curricula resources on numeracy.
- 2. Carry out Professional Developments for teachers on the delivery of numeracy outcomes.
- 3. Monitor and report on the numeracy progress of students at all levels.
- 4. Ability to facilitate and organize training workshops, community sensitization workshops, and peer monitoring.

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1 Identify and develop learning materials that meet the learning needs of Tuvaluans.
- 1.2 Responsible for providing the required resource on numeracy to schools.
- 2.1 Responsible for carrying out professional developments for teachers on the delivery of numeracy outcomes.
- 2.2 Provide support for teachers on teaching of Math at all levels.
- 2.3 Work with the Department of Education to develop a clear understanding of what numeracy is and present as a strategy for discussion.
- 3.1 Monitor and report on the numeracy progress of students in each school to the SEO Curriculum.
- 3.2 Monitor and report on the numeracy progress of students in each school at all levels.
- 3.3 Audit school literacy resources and teacher capabilities develop a clear understanding of the challenges facing schools in teaching reading and writing.
- 3.4 Identify what has been done in the past, gather relevant resources from past projects, and identify what worked and what did not.
- 3.5 Keep updated with report writing to provide tangible evidence of impact of changes.

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- 4.1 Develop an in-school based professional development program to train/coach teachers. and head teachers in teaching classroom literacy programs.
- 4.2 Parents involvement in Numeracy program, planning and implementing.
- 4.3 Parents and stakeholder consultation literacy awareness and expectations.
